

#### A Dutch Boy Pan Cake

# Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 tablespoons of margarine or butter
- 3 eggs
- 1 Tablespoon brown sugar, packed
- 1/4 cup biscuit mix
- 1/4 cup milk

## Steps:

- Preheat your oven to 450 °F (232 °C).
- Coat the insides of a 9" pie pan with all of the butter
- Combine all of the rest of the ingredients. If using a blender or mixer, blend on low speed for about three minutes. If doing it by hand, mix it thoroughly and longer.
- Pour the butter into the pie pan.
- Bake for 20 minutes at 450 and then reduce the oven to 350 and bake for 10 more minutes.
- Remove the Pancake carefully with a pot holder and spatula.
- Cut the Pancake in half, placing each half on its own plate.
- Choose a topping to go on it.
  - ➤ Lemon topping: Top with butter and powdered sugar and place lemon wedges on the plate.
  - Applesauce topping: Heat the applesauce. Spoon 4 tablespoons lightly over the pancake. Sprinkle with cinnamon.
  - > Strawberry topping: The night before you need it, place 1/2 cup of strawberries into a bowl and sprinkle lightly with 1 tablespoon lemon juice. Store in the refrigerator. Pour on top of the Pancake and add whipped topping (optional)

#### **ICE STORM**

When warm and cold air meet, the resulting weather phenomena can be an ice storm. Ice storms can be particularly dangerous because the freezing rain makes an icy glaze on roads and other outdoor surfaces. Very heavy amounts of ice brutally damage trees and weigh down electrical connection. In fact, the weight of the ice can be increased by 30 times. The weight of the ice is made worse if the wind speed is high. The areas with the highest frequency of freezing rain occasions are the Midwest and Northeast.

The accumulations of ice are classified according to the impacts they have. They are classified as nuisance, disruptive, and crippling. During a nuisance ice storm event, less than ¼ of an inch of ice accumulates. Travel, especially on roads with bridges, can be difficult. Disruptive ice storms are typically an ice accumulation of ¼ of an inch to ½ of an inch. During these storms there can be outages and sagging of breaking tree limbs. The most dangerous ice storm is the crippling variety. This category of storm causes widespread ice accumulations of over ½ inch, and may reach accumulations of one inch. Due to severe damage to trees and electrical connection, electricity may be interrupted for many days. This is especially dangerous for those who do not have back-up power solutions and go for prolonged periods with no heat.

A black hole is a place in space where gravity pulls so much that even light cannot get out. The gravity is so strong that matter has been squeezed into a tiny space. This can happen when a star is dying. Because no light can get out, people cannot see black holes. They are invisible.

Black holes can be big or small. Scientists think the smallest black holes are as small as just one atom. These black holes are very tiny but have the mass of a large mountain. Mass is the amount of matter, or "stuff," in an object. Another kind of black hole is called "stellar." Its mass can be up to 20 times more than the mass of the sun. The largest black holes are called "supermassive." These black holes have masses that are more than 1 million suns together. Scientists have found proof that every large galaxy contains a supermassive black hole at its center.

A black hole cannot be seen since strong gravity pulls all of the light into the middle of the black hole. But scientists can see how the strong gravity affects the stars and gas around the black hole. Scientists can study stars to find out if they are flying around, or orbiting, a black hole.

When a black hole and a star are close together, high-energy light is made. This kind of light cannot be seen with human eyes. Scientists use satellites and telescopes in space to see the high-energy light.
